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LEAVE NO TRACE LEVEL 1 INSTRUCTOR HYBRID COURSE EXPECTATIONS

This course provides participants with a comprehensive overview of Leave No Trace skills and ethics through practical application in a field-based setting. Students will practice Leave No Trace teaching strategies by delivering a planned lesson. The Level 1 Instructor course prepares students to deliver 1 day or shorter Awareness Workshops.

Hybrid course: Consists of a ½ day online meeting followed by remote learning on our CANVAS platform and culminating in basecamping and practice teaching at Landmark's Downstream Campus.

Course Hours

2 days/ 16-20 hours of course curriculum

Attendance & Participation

Students are required to attend all class sessions and field exercises. Students may request no more than 10% of the course hours of excused absence, and may not miss the first day of the course. Review of missed curriculum or examinations is the student's responsibility. Absences, either unexcused or exceeding 10% of the course hours excused, are grounds for dismissal from the course and cancellation policies will apply.

Performance Outcomes

Each Level 2 Instructor candidate is expected to teach one of the 7 principles of Leave No Trace to the class, incorporating into their topic the content and style necessary to teach a group they may encounter as a Level 1 Instructor after this course. In presenting your topic please keep in mind the audience that you will be presenting to in your professional capacity. In preparing your topic, imagine that your classmates know nothing about Leave No Trace. The Teaching Topic is the cornerstone of the Level 1 Instructor experience. It provides the opportunity to prepare a lesson plan, deliver it, and receive immediate feedback from peers and instructors.

Each candidate will be evaluated through peer review and course instructors for depth of content, appropriateness for the chosen audience, and instructional style.
