



How To Get WCU Academic Credit For Your Landmark Learning Course(s)

Determine your WCU student eligibility category below and registration instructions based on this category:

1. You are a current WCU student seeking to receive academic credit as a part of your regular course load in the fall or spring semester for either PRM 357: Wilderness First Responder or PRM 252: Wilderness First Aid.
Registration Instructions: Students interested in the designated PRM 252 or PRM 357 available for Financial Aid billing should register at Landmark Learning using the code **NOLSWCU** which should result in no payment due to Landmark Learning. Then complete the WCU Qualtrics Form. Your student account will be billed for the Landmark Learning course fee plus a \$50 administrative fee.
2. You are a current WCU student that wants to register for any other Landmark Learning course (*not the PRM 252 or 357 noted above*) during the fall or spring semester.
Registration Instructions: Register AND at pay Landmark Learning, complete the WCU Qualtrics Form and pay a \$50 administrative fee through the WCU's Division of Educational Outreach.
3. You are a current WCU student interested in academic credit for a Landmark Learning course during the summer or winter break.
Registration Instructions: Register AND pay at Landmark Learning, complete the WCU Qualtrics Form and pay for the academic credits (\$55/credit hour) through the WCU's Division of Educational Outreach.
4. You are a non-WCU student any time of the year.
Registration Instructions: Register AND pay at Landmark Learning, complete the WCU Qualtrics Form. Apply as a non-degree seeking student at WCU and pay the application fee (currently \$65). Once accepted, pay for the academic credits (\$55/credit hour) through the WCU's Division of Educational Outreach.

- Complete THIS Qualtrics Form. This lets WCU know that you are interested in receiving academic credit for the course(s) you complete at Landmark Learning.
 - NOTE: If this course puts you above 16 credit hours for the semester, you will need to complete a "Request to Schedule an Overload" form to the Registrar's Office.

Course Grades and Transcript Process:

- Your registration with WCU's Division of Educational Outreach must take place prior to your course dates to remain eligible for WCU academic credit.
- Attend and successfully complete your course. Your course transcript and grade will be provided to Brittany Marshall (Associate Director of Continuing Education and Workforce Training, Educational Outreach) following successful course completion and entered on your academic record at WCU.
- Requests for credit transfer to your school can be made at the WCU Registrar's office at the end of the semester in which your course was completed.
